

## **The Nicholas D. Diamantides Scholarship Fund**

The Nicholas D. Diamantides Scholarship Fund has been established in memory of Nicholas D. Diamantides, to recognize the academic excellence that was evident in his many scholarly activities and interests, which included, among other areas of inquiry, engineering, mathematics, demography, economics, and history. The Award seeks to promote scholarly accomplishments among members of the Greek American community of Akron, Ohio.

### **Conditions of Eligibility**

- Applicants should be members of the Greek American community of Akron, Ohio who are currently in the senior year of their undergraduate studies and intending to pursue graduate studies in the fall semester or who are presently enrolled full-time in a Master's or Doctoral program.
- The scholarship will be awarded to a student applicant with an outstanding university record at the undergraduate or graduate levels (e.g., minimum 3.5 GPA), and/or has made an important research contribution recently or has one in process.

Applicants are required to submit a completed scholarship application which includes the following:

- 1. Official transcript from the college where the applicant is currently enrolled.*
- 2. If the applicant has been accepted to a graduate college, an official copy of the school's acceptance letter.*
- 3. At least one letter (and preferably two letters) of recommendation from a department head, advisor, or instructor in the current school of attendance.*
- 4. A one-page statement summarizing scholarly accomplishments and future program of study.*

- Recipients are selected solely at the discretion of the Executive Board of the Nicholas Diamantides Scholarship Fund on an annual basis. However, recipients may apply for a renewal of the scholarship.
- In the event of a withdrawal, the recipient will be expected to return the unused portion of the scholarship.
- In the event of failure to enroll, the recipient will be obligated to return the entire amount of the scholarship.
- The Board reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship if the student's performance is not satisfactory.
- Applications are available in the Church office. **The deadline for submission is May 1.**

- All applications and documents submitted are confidential and non-returnable.
