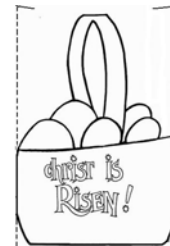


PASCHA CARD 2011

For Shut-ins, Grandparents, Godparents, some one who is ill...

MATERIALS:

1. Copies of the card on card stock; suggest enlarging to the edge
2. 1 envelope for each card 3.5" X 5.5"
3. Pens or fine tip black marker for *In Class #5*
4. Colored markers, crayons or colored pencils
5. Scissors, if cards are to be cut out
6. White out, if students are to keep the card intact
7. Foamie precut pieces: crosses, flowers, etc. or stickers
8. Glue sticks



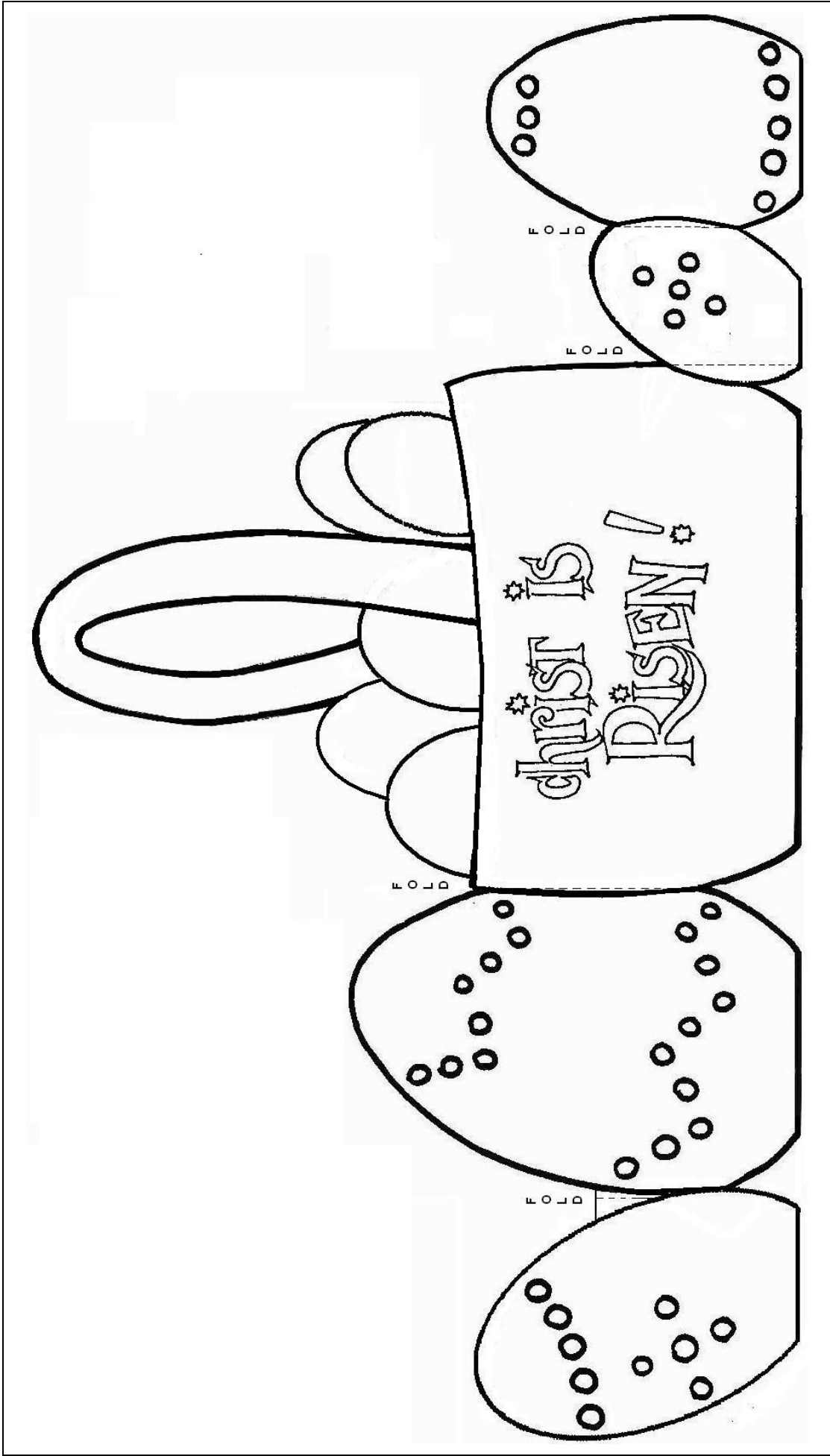
DIRECTIONS

Before Class

1. If younger students are to color cut out cards, ask adults to do the cutting before class.
2. If you want rectangular cards, cover the word "FOLD" with white-out before copying, then use a paper cutter to cut the cards.
3. Address the envelopes, depending on the purpose of the project..
 - a. Shut-ins names are available from the church office/priest.
 - b. Several weeks before, ask parents to send in names and addresses of grandparents, godparents or some one who is ill.

In Class:

1. Distribute 1 card & 1 addressed envelope to each student.
2. Place the other supplies in the center of the work areas.
3. Inform the students to cut out the basket and eggs on the outside of the dark line so the lines shows. [if students do the cutting.]
4. Instruct the students to fold their cards along the dotted lines so that the bottom sections of the basket are aligned. Some students may need help. Show them a folded card.
5. Tell the students to write their names, ages, grades and Church on the back of the card.
6. Ask the students add a message. [Opt.]
7. Direct the students to decorate their cards by coloring, adding stickers and/or gluing foamie pieces, but not to glue the foamies on the folds. [Show them what would occur.]
8. Ask the students to fold and place their cards in the addressed envelopes.
9. Mail the card for the students. The Sunday Church School should pay for the stamps.



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
