



BALLOON REVIEW

Here's an idea to help put a little "pop" into Review Sessions!

Make sure to tell your students ahead of time that you will be reviewing a particular unit / lesson at the next session and that you have surprise for them. This activity may be played individually or in teams for added excitement.

MATERIALS

- ✓ Balloons
- ✓ String
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Tape or Push Pins
- ✓ Options:
 1. Paper & pencils
 2. Small Trinkets

- o Before blowing up several colored balloons, write the review questions on small slips of paper.
- o Place one inside each balloon before inflating.
- o Tie strings on the end of each balloon and pin or tape them in rows across the bulletin or chalk board.
- o The students are to go to the board one at a time, choose a balloon to pop, then try to answer the question inside.

If this is played with teams, the team with the most correct answers is tops!

Alternative #1

- o Purchase small, inexpensive trinkets and insert one in each balloon before inflating them.
- o Tie strings on the end of each balloon and pin or tape them in rows across the bulletin or chalk board.
- o On the day of the "quiz," give each student an opportunity to answer a question.
- o A correct answer earns a student the right to select a balloon, pop it, and get the trinket.

Alternative #2

- o Number small pieces of paper with "points" and insert the "points" inside the balloons before inflating.
- o Tie strings on the end of each balloon and pin or tape them in rows across the bulletin or chalk board.
- o On the day of the "quiz," ask each student a question.
- o A correct answer earns the student the right to pop a balloon and keep the points.

If this is played with teams, the team with the most "points" is tops!

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
