
The Holy Land Poster Project

CONNECTING US TO JESUS CHRIST

When I was young, I found a book about the Holy Land; the images of the holy sites fascinated me—Bethlehem, Golgotha, Cana—these were the places where Jesus walked and lived! *He was real!*

Images of all sorts surround us today. If your children text, tweet, and Facebook, they live in a world of distraction—is Jesus even on their radar? *Let's get back to basics—our faith, and our life itself, rests in a person who lived 2,000 years ago and lives still.* Donate a poster to your church school and begin to surround the children with **images that remind them of the reality of Jesus!**



THE IMMORTAL CONQUEROR POSTER

The words on the poster are: “Thy Resurrection, O Christ, our Savior, the angels in heaven sing! Enable us on earth to glorify Thee in purity of heart.” Orthodox Christians celebrate Pascha at the revered site of the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus Christ, in the Church of the Holy Resurrection, Old City Jerusalem. The words on the poster are: “Today is suspended upon the tree, He who suspended the earth upon the waters.” Chapel of Golgotha within the Church of the Holy Resurrection, Old City Jerusalem. In front of the icon of the Bridegroom is an opening commemorating the place where the life-giving cross was raised.
