What did the father do when his son returned in the gospel story of the Prodigal Son? / He welcomed him with open arms, gave him a ring, a coat &amp; offered a feast.</p>	<p>74. How is the date of Pascha/Easter determined? / The first Sunday after the spring equinox, after Passover.</p>
<p>75. There are two Sunday Gospels that can be used to announce the coming of the Lenten season. What are they? / Zaccheus and the Syro-Phonician woman who asks Jesus to heal her daughter.</p>	<p>76. What is the difference between the Ascension of Our Lord and Pentecost? / The Ascension-Jesus' rising to God the Father on the 40<sup>th</sup> day after His resurrection. Pentecost -Descent of the Holy Spirit on the Disciples on the 50<sup>th</sup> day.</p>	<p>77. What is a publican and why were they disliked? / A tax collector. Publicans were Israelites hired by the Romans to collect taxes. Many cheated the people and kept the extra money for themselves.</p>
<p>78. What is another name for Cheese-Fare Sunday? / Forgiveness Sunday or The Expulsion of Adam &amp; Eve from paradise.</p>	<p>79. What book did St. John Climacus write? / <i>The Ladder of Divine Ascent.</i></p>	<p>80. The sign above Jesus' head was written in 3 languages. What were they &amp; why were they used? / Hebrew for the Jews; Latin for the Romans; Greek for all the rest of the people. Greek was the common language of the people.</p>
