














MEMORY VERSES for PASCHA SYMBOLS

 <p>CROWN OF THORNS</p>	<p>"They made a crown out of thorny branches and placed it on his head." Matthew 27:29</p>
 <p>DOUBTING THOMAS</p>	<p>"Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe." John 20:29</p>
 <p>EMPTY TOMB</p>	<p>"Do not be afraid, you seek Jesus of Nazareth who was crucified. He is risen!" Mark 16:6</p>
 <p>EPITAPHIOS</p>	<p>"Every generation comes to Your grave bringing its dirge of praises, dear Christ." Holy Friday Hymn</p>
 <p>GETHSEMANE</p>	<p>"My father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will." Matthew 26:39</p>
 <p>PALM SUNDAY</p>	<p>"Praise God! (Hosanna!) 'Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!'" John 12:13</p>
 <p>PENTECOST</p>	<p>"They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to talk in other languages as the Spirit enabled them to speak." Acts 2:4</p>
 <p>RESURRECTION CANDLE</p>	<p>"Come, receive the unwaning light and let us glorify Christ who is resurrected from the dead." Pascha liturgy</p>
 <p>SEALED TOMB</p>	<p>"So they went and made the sepulcher secure by sealing the stone and setting a guard." Matthew 27:66</p>
 <p>SPEAR & SPOON</p>	<p>"One of the soldiers, however, plunged his spear into Jesus' side, and at once blood and water poured out." John 19:34</p>
