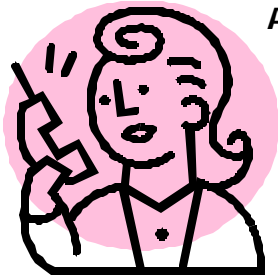


REVIEWING LESSONS WITH PRESCHOOLERS



After teaching a Bible story or another church school lesson, hand a toy telephone to one of your preschoolers. Use a second toy phone to pretend you are calling the child. When he answers the phone, the conversation can go something like this:

"Hello, this is Miss Barbara. Who is this?"

"This is Tommy."

"Tommy, can you tell me. . ."

(Ask a question concerning the lesson you want to review.)

When he gives the correct answer, praise him for listening so well and thank him for giving you the answer.

Then tell him you want to call the person sitting next to him. Would he please hang up the phone and pass it to _____.

Continue calling the children until each one has had a turn to talk to the teacher.

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
