



STUDENT SPOTLIGHT

Use an extra bulletin board or an empty classroom wall or door to focus attention on each of your student's unique skills, interests and abilities.

- ★ Label the area "Student Spotlight" and each week/month let that spotlight shine on a different student.
- ★ The area is for the student to tell about himself/herself.
- ★ Encourage each student to display photographs, hobby samples, brief biography, artwork, etc. - whatever serves to tell that student's story.
- ★ You may wish to set aside, some time for the "spotlighted student to explain his/her display.
- ★ Students will not only gain confidence themselves, but will also learn to recognize and respect the special talents and abilities of others!

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DOUBLE DUTY BOOKCASES

- ♦ Instead of pushing bookshelves against the wall, have them serve as room dividers.
- ♦ Place them perpendicular to the wall to section off your classroom into small interest centers or work areas.
- ♦ Use the back of each bookcase for extra bulletin board space by mounting cork on it.
- ♦ Now you have plenty of space to display the students' works, and at eye level, too!

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
