Two Scholarships will be given annually to one graduate or undergraduate student. To be considered, applicants or their parents must be Orthodox Christians and must submit their application and official transcripts of their academic work by April 15. The selection of the qualifying scholarship award winners is the responsibility of the Scholarship Committee.

The Scholarship Committee’s evaluation of all applications will be based on:

1. Course work during the semester prior to the Application.
2. Complexity of courses taken.
3. Grade point average, for the course work completed and overall.
4. Time spent outside the classroom, working to pay for own expenses.
5. Membership and time spent in school-related organizations.
6. Volunteer work in school or church activities.
7. Commitment to and participation in Church organizations.
8. Proof of financial need (if appropriate).
