

- **1.) Priest Report:** Thank you for being here. Ministries in full swing. Overall, the festival was a smooth and enjoyable experience for the community.
- 2.) President Report: : In addition to structural improvements previously identified, the boiler was red tagged for repairs. Entire building and grounds project will cost an estimated \$500,000-600,000. Bill Farmakidis has been added to building and grounds committee. Update will be given at November General Assembly.

- **5.] Financial:** Van Doros \$892,697 in trust fund, this year earned approximately \$62,000 on the investments for that fund.
- **6.] Hall:** Bollas Check for June-July totaling \$3970 has been received. Events scheduled through June 2024.
- 7.] Good of the Community: Mission Walk coming up. Over 100 participants registered.

ACOLYTES

We start off this month's AXIOS column with yet another Greek language lesson. When we want to say "AXIOS" to a group of people, we say "AXIOI".

This month, we are recognizing a special group of boys (and men) who we see every Sunday in church. They serve our priests during liturgy in the altar, in processions, and during communion.

Although we call them altar boys, Father Dean wants us to know that the proper term for those who assist our priests is Acolytes. The adult males who wear black robes and also assist during services are known as adult Acolytes. Or, as Frank Pangas was once called by one of the younger Acolytes, "Altar Boy Man".

Our church's 17 Acolytes serve in three teams which alternate over the year. They are:
