Each February we are offered the opportunity to reflect on this text from the Matins service for the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, which we celebrate on February 2nd.

After reading that some of us may be thinking, "from the *what service*, Father?" The Matins service.

How many of us are aware that, before we Come to Church for Divine Liturgy at 9:30am, there has already been an hour of worship? Each Sunday two talented groups of chanters, comprised of men and women of varying ages, chant hymns and read prayers. The service of Matins, also known as Orthros, is not only musically stunning, but it is the ultimate experience in Christian education.

Our songful morning begins with a musical reminder that God became man for us. We hear stirring melodies about the myrrh bearing women encountering an angel at

the Lord's empty tomb. There are readings and hymns about the Saints being commemorated that day. Did you know that every day is somebody's Name Day? There are hymns about the current season of the Church year. And each Sunday we hear a musical proclamation of the Resurrection of Christ and His victory over death. And no two Matins services are the same.

Can you imagine that much opportunity for education, prayer, and beautiful singing in just one hour? It happens every Sunday from 8:30-9:30. This week, arrive a little earlier than usual. Experience some of this service. Your cantors are warmed up and ready. All you need to do is **#ComeToChurchForMatins**
