I had a moment today that was really remarkable. I paged through a Thesaurus then looked up at the wall of icons in my home, and the dissonance between the two was real.

Does anyone even remember what a Thesaurus is anymore? I barely do- it's basically like a dictionary- it sorts through words and offers a concise definition to them, pairing them together based on their meanings.

Even though they've become irrelevant lately, the idea behind a Thesaurus is alive and well- the idea of a system- that we can track things down and label them, form them into a framework that can explain everything.

But where is the love of God to be found in those pages, in these systems we like to make? The love that the saints in the icons had for Him, the love they would have (and often did) die for? The love that connects everything? The love we were meant for, the love only found in Christ?

And if we look deep within ourselves, amongst this world of ideas and definitions, we can often find a yearning, a thirst, completely unexplainable-one beyond the grasp of all definition. That's where relationship with Christ begins.

Philoptochos Melissa donated over \$13,000 last year and we are looking to do more this year!




We all enjoyed our first meeting and making plans for this year.


