I wonder how many of us grew up confused about our faith. Maybe we had questions nobody could answer, not even our parents or Sunday School teachers. Maybe those questions are still with us as adults? I don't necessarily mean complicated theological issues, although we might wonder about those as well. How many of us understand how and when we should pray? Do we know how and when an Orthodox Christian should read the Bible? What about applying those topics to our lives broadly?

This semester our Adult Sunday School program will feature these two topics. Aris Spirtos' six-week class, which continues through October, will teach us the important role that prayer and stillness play in our lives. His class will feature discussions and lectures based on two classic Orthodox texts, "The Way of the Pilgrim" and "The Philokalia."

In November Deacon Mark Studebaker will begin a six-week class on reading the Bible. The Bible holds a preeminent position in the Orthodox Holy Tradition. But do we know how to read it? Have we ever considered why the Old and New Testaments sound so different? Once we read it, how do we make it applicable to our lives? Deacon Mark will delve into all of this and more!

Adult Sunday School meets in the Chapel on Sundays at 11:15. Don't miss this incredible opportunity to deepen your faith and get answers to questions new and old.



Now that we have competed another successful festival, let's learn a bit about one of our favorite parts of the festival, our **GREEK DANCE TROUPE**. For nearly 60 years, our parish's children have entertained large audiences at our annual festivals. In the 1970s, Mrs. Helene Patitsas revitalized the program with a passion and energy that inspired a large number of students (including all six of her children) to learn Greek dancing.

Teresa Fox, who now co-directs the program with her sister Christina Tharp, says "I remember being so inspired by watching them do the sailor dance and saying I wanted to learn to do that. Athina Bellios and I were so excited when we got to lead the Ikarian dance. Mrs. Patitsas always made it fun."

The Annunciation dancers are now comprised of three groups: the **KOUKLAKIA** (ages 3- second grade), the **JUNIOR DANCERS** (third to sixth grade), and the **SENIOR DANCERS** (seventh to twelfth grade).

Though the festival (and practices) take place during a busy time of year for students, they show up to

practice and are committed to the dance ministry. As Teresa Fox noted, "they understand this is service to their community in addition to being a fun activity!"
