



Praying With Icons

Jim Forest – 3rd Ed – 2025 – Orbis Books

Jim Forest's classic work on Praying With Icons is now out posthumously in a new third edition. In the book, he reviews what the Orthodox Church says about icons, how

they are made, and the Tradition regarding icons. He then reviews in more detail some common icons of Christ, Mary, the Feasts of the Church, and selected Saints. He poetically describes how the elements of each scene, speak to us, teach us and draw us into communion with the person or event depicted. He also discusses the Orthodox Tradition of prayer,



and then the custom of praying with icons, particularly in personal daily prayer.

Mr. Foret, a convert to Orthodoxy, writes in an extremely relatable style. We had the privilege of having him in our home many years ago. He was the kind of person who made whomever he was with feel loved and at peace. Until his death last year, he was a prolific author and was a founding member of the Orthodox Peace Fellowship (https://incommunion.org).




As our parish's new chapel nears completion of the final phase of its décor, we want to acknowledge the artisans whose skills contributed to the beauty of our **Saints Cosmas and Damian Chapel**.

Master carver Kostantinos Papadakis, who carved the new icon screen and furniture for our main church in the past, worked with his assistant Paul Sirba on the beautiful icon screen for the chapel; following Costa's untimely passing from cancer, Paul completed the icon screen on his own. The cost of the icon screen was gifted by Mrs. Joanne Papas in memory of her husband, Dr. Harry Papas.

The chapel's beautiful stained glass windows were created at Rohlf's Stained and Leaded Glass Studio in Mount Vernon, New York. This studio was chosen for their authentic Byzantine-style artistry, and their windows have helped transform our chapel into a truly worshipful place. This beautiful addition to the chapel was donated by Dr. Nick and Barb Papas.

Iconographer George Lagonis of Pittsburgh painted the icons for the icon screen in the chapel, and is currently working on the icons for the apse and platytera in the







chapel. He also painted the icons of Jesus and Panaghia that are on icon stands in the narthex of our main church.
